



Liddiard Road Primary School - Statement of Behaviour Expectations

At Liddiard Road Primary School students will behave in a respectful, safe and engaged manner, which should be supported by both staff and parents from our school. These behaviours help make our school a place where everyone can succeed.

Our **students** will demonstrate **respectful** behaviour by:

- following staff instructions and school rules.
- caring for school property and others' belongings.
- using respectful language.

They will demonstrate **safe** behaviours by:

- keeping themselves and others safe from harm.
- speaking up or seeking help from an adult if they or someone else is being treated unfairly.
- only bringing safe and necessary items to school.

They will demonstrate that they're **engaged** by:

- attending school every day.
- trying their best.
- asking for help and knowing the school's policies, for example our policy on mobile phone use.

Our **parents** and carers will support their children's understanding of these behaviours by modelling and encouraging positive behaviour so that they can develop habits that allow them to be successful at school and in the wider community.

Parents can support their children's understanding of **respect** by:

- knowing the school's rules and supporting them at home.
- modelling respectful behaviour when speaking to and about school staff, families, and others both online and in person.
- making use of the school's resolution processes to raise and solve concerns early.

Parents can support their children to develop **safe** behaviours by:

- working together with staff to resolve any issues at school.
- ensuring that their children know it's okay to ask for help.
- ensuring that their child stays safe online by talking with them and addressing concerns early.

Parents can help their children **engage** with school by:

- making sure they're at school every day.
- communicating with school to support their child's learning and wellbeing.
- talking to their child about their day at school and encouraging their learning by noticing their efforts and progress.

Our **school** will support students to develop these behaviours by teaching and reinforcing positive behaviour, ensuring positive, safe and fair learning environments that focus on learning and wellbeing.

The **school** will support students to develop **respectful** behaviours by:

- teaching and demonstrating school rules and modelling positive behaviours.

- explicitly teaching, modelling and acknowledging expected respectful behaviours.
- engaging collaboratively and positively with all students, parents and carers.

The **school** will provide a **safe** learning environment by:

- having clear policies and procedures to prevent bullying and to keep students safe.
- proactively identifying and addressing problems to maintain a physically, socially and culturally safe environment.

The **school** will support the students to develop their understanding of **engaged** behaviours by:

- delivering evidence based, inclusive education that meets the needs of all students.
- empowering students to have a say in decisions that affect their learning.
- building strong, trusting relationships to ensure all students feel seen, heard and valued.
